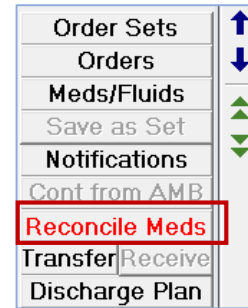


Admission Home Medication Reconciliation

Medication reconciliation is the required process of carefully considering a complete and accurate home medication list and continuing those medications as appropriate.

Medication reconciliation is designed to keep patients safe by preventing omissions and duplications, dosing errors, or potentially serious drug interactions.



Select the **Order** tab then select **Reconcile Meds**

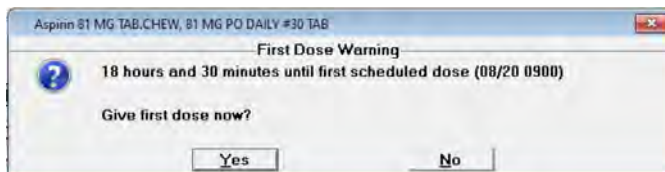
Medications *do carry over* from previous hospitalizations. The Review date and time will be filled out once the nurse has validated that the patient is *currently* taking this medication. If known, the Last Taken date/time will be entered by the nurse.

To continue the medications individually, place a check next to the medication or click the gray box with the check mark to continue *all* medications.



A series of pop-ups appear related to the medications that have been selected. The medication name is located in the blue header.

If a drug is non-formulary or bulk, the provider cannot simply continue the medication. The provider will be taken to a search field where they will manually enter NF to enter a non-formulary medication. The medication name is located in the blue header.

Once all medications and pop-ups have been addressed, you will be taken back to the Med Rec screen where you will click **Done**. Click **Submit** and enter your PIN to finalize the ordering process.
